Natural Hazards and Disasters, 4e Plate Tectonics and Physical Hazards 8 Hotspots form chains of volcanoes within individual plates rather than near plate boundaries Because lithosphere is moving over hotspots fixed in the Earth's underlying asthenosphere, hotspots grow as a trailing track of progressively older extinct volcanoes
